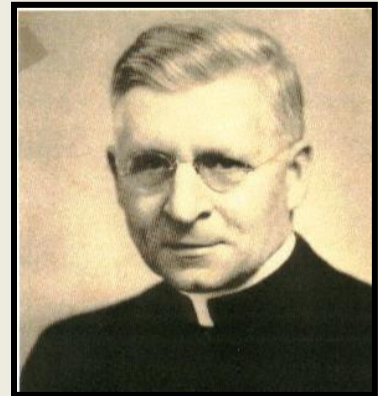

SASEAS ALUMNI SHARE THE FAITH



SASEAS Alumni chairperson, Judy Ivers Johnson (Class of '61), is happy to announce the recent presentation of three scholarships sponsored by the SASEAS Alumni Committee in the memory of Rev. Otto J. Herrmann, pastor of St. Andrew Parish from 1947 to 1960. Father Herrmann lived his life as

he taught, clearly, directly, and with a sincere commitment to Christian values. His vision was to construct and create the largest and the best Catholic Elementary School in the Cincinnati area. As much as he enjoyed watching the construction of St. Andrew School in 1947, the new rectory in 1952, the convent in 1956, and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton School in 1959, he enjoyed even more seeing young lives molded and shaped by Catholic Christian values. As Principal Donna Beebe put it "We are the largest Catholic elementary school in the Cincinnati area, and in my heart, I know we are the best."



On January 24th of this year, 180 SASEAS alumni plus friends, gathered for a reunion. Due to the large crowd, and generous business and private donations of cash and food for the event, the SASEAS Alumni Committee, after paying expenses, came up with a surplus which they hadn't anticipated. In the past, Joanne Sylvester Smith, President of SASEAS PTO (Class of '72) has fostered the possibility of using any extra funds for scholarships for SASEAS students. Deacon Tim Schutte, (Class of '74), vocalized his support of this idea by saying that "using the profits for scholarship funds would bring to fruition what ***Celebratio Fidei*** is all about. It will be a way of alumni passing on the faith through our Catholic schools and their donations." The Alumni Committee unanimously agreed.

FATHER HERRMANN AWARD PRESENTATIONS

The three 2004 Father Herrmann Christian Values awards were presented as follows: 1. A \$500 financial aid scholarship to provide assistance to a family who wants to give their child a Catholic education; 2. Two \$250 scholarships awarded to students at Seton and St. Andrew campuses for exemplifying the Christian values taught in the SASEAS system.

Alex Breeze, a fifth grader at Seton, and the daughter of Debbie Breeze and the late Gary Breeze, was awarded the "Rev. Otto J. Herrmann Christian Values Award" at the school closing prayer service on Thursday, June 10th. Alexandra Breeze was nominated by her teachers for the alumni-funded scholarship because her Christian example is what best exemplifies a SASEAS student. Her teachers feel that "this soft-spoken young lady has risen above her personal losses to demonstrate not only to peers, but faculty and staff as well, the true meaning of 1Corinthians 13:4-7. She is 'patient and kind, never rude or boastful and slow to anger'. Choosing her for any task that needs to be done means that the job will be successfully accomplished (sometimes with improvements). Alex searches for the good in people in all situations. She recognizes when others are hurting and puts their needs ahead of her own. She asks for forgiveness and is quick to forgive others, all in the true Christian spirit. Her life experiences have blessed her with wisdom beyond her years."
